Shooters from all over U.P. are invited for participation in the said competition. The terms & conditions for the competition will be as under: -

**MATCHES:** All the matches will be conducted according to UPSRA Match Book. Tournament will be played as per ISSF rules under qualified officials deputed by UPSRA and **matches will be played on EST.**

**PARTICIPATION:** Participation is open to competitors belonging to Uttar Pradesh only. Shooters furnishing wrong information or giving wrong domicile will be immediately debarred. **Shooters must have ID Cards.**

**CRITERIA for PARTICIPATION:** **Participation and qualifying in Pre-UP State Shooting Competition is compulsory for those shooters who will be participating in 49<sup>th</sup> U.P. State Shooting Championship Competition for the first time. A minimum of 50% score is required in Pre-UP State to qualify for U.P. State Shooting Championship Competition. Those shooters who failed to attain 50% will not be allowed to participate in U.P. State Shooting Championship Competition.**

Those shooters who have participated in previous UPSSCC and failed to attain 50% score in their respective event (Air Pistol or Air Rifle), it is mandatory for them to participate in Pre-UP State Shooting Competition and to attain 50% scores and to get qualify for 49<sup>th</sup> U.P. State Shooting Championship Competition.

**THE ENTRIES WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED THROUGH "NRAI'S ONLINE SYSTEM".** Shooters applying for the competition will be required to visit <https://thenrai.org/> and follow the steps accordingly to file their entries along with online payment of entry fee. The online entries with **normal fee will be accepted till 05:00 PM on 23.05.2026.** Late entries with **double entry fee will be accepted till 02:00 PM on 25.05.2026.** Please note that no entries will be accepted that do not fulfill the above requirements and should be submitted online.

**It will be mandatory for all shooters to register with UPSRA & NRAI prior to participation in this competition. Shooters, who are already registered with NRAI need not fill online registration form. Shooters are required to get their competitor cards printed in advance and to keep as proof of participation, without the copy of which, otherwise NO CERTIFICATES WILL BE PROVIDED.**

**NOTE: While filling the entry shooters have to Tick (✓) the "Life Membership" Option.**

**IT IS MANDATORY FOR SHOOTERS TO FILL THEIR UP SHOOTERS ID (even if temporary). Otherwise, Competitors Cards will not be issued.**

**A penalty of Rs.500/- will be charged if a Shooter loses his/her Competitor Card during the Championship and duplicate card will only be issued on deposit of Penalty.**

**It is the duty of the shooter to get the sign. and stamp from the official concerned before getting themselves registered for the details and lane allocation.**

**In case any shooter/affiliated DRA/C & UNIT need any assistance for filing the entry, they must approach UPSRA office on phone number 0522-2208510 strictly during working hours (10am to 5 pm). Shooters may also send email on [upsra\\_1@hotmail.com](mailto:upsra_1@hotmail.com).**

**BOARDING/LODGING:** It will be the responsibility of the shooters to make arrangements for their boarding and lodging.

**DISPUTES:** In case participants have any complaint or there is any dispute, he/she **must give the same in writing immediately** to any member of the Jury for redressing his/her complaint/dispute together with Rs.500/-, Protest Fee. The fee will be returned if the protest is upheld and retained by UPSRA if the protest is lost.

**Shri Jagdeep Madhok, Senior Vice President, UPSRA,** will be in charge of maintaining discipline on the Ranges. Any decision taken by him with regard to any indiscipline will be binding upon the person/persons concerned.

**JURY:** The Jury will consist of following Members: -

The decision of the members of the Jury shall be final and binding upon the complainant.

**GUEST ENTRY:** Shooters from other States are permitted to participate as **Guest Shooters**. Their entry will not be eligible for any medals or ranking and will have to make their own arrangement of Weapons and Air Pellets, both for practice and matches. The Entries to be submitted offline by Demand Draft. Entry Fee will be **triple times** the normal fee in all the events.

**Documents to be submitted for Guest Entries:**

1. Entry Form duly filled.
2. Two passport size Photographs.
3. Recommendation on Entry Form from Coach, or respective State Rifle Association's Representative or by any International Shooter or National Coach.
4. Self-Attested copy of Shooters ID Card (State or National) of the recommending International Shooter/National Coach.
5. **Last date for submitting Guest Entries is 03.06.2026 till noon.**

**NOTE:** Guest Entry will be accepted on the basis of First come First Serve. UPSRA does not guarantee to accept each and every Guest Entry; however, every effort will be made. **Entry Fee will not be refunded. Any decision taken by U.P. State Rifle Association will be final and binding.**

**IMPORTANT:**

1. All participants are requested to go through the instructions carefully and ensure strict compliance.
2. All participants are expected to abide by the rules and regulations for the Championship. Discipline on and off the field is very essential.
3. The Organizers will have the right to stop any match or event in case of any emergency without assigning any reason for such an action on their part.
4. In case of non-participation by the competitors after submission of their entries, **the entry fee will not be refunded.**
5. In case of any accident or harm caused by a participant to himself/herself or to any other person at the range, neither UPSRA, Lucknow nor Officials at NOIDA will be held responsible for the same in any manner whatsoever.
6. The Competitors shall observe strict safety regulations and range discipline.
7. Shooters shall not load commence firing unless on the firing line and only when appropriate firing order is given by the Range Officer. The competitors shall carry all weapons with bolts/actions open at all times except on the firing line.
8. Shooters furnishing wrong information regarding their date of birth; caught indulging in any unfair means or indulging in any indiscipline may be debarred for two years from taking part in any shooting championship.
9. **Participants are forbidden to practice with their weapons in their hotels and public places.**
10. Clothes and Equipment to be used as per ISSF Rules. Jeans and camouflage will not be allowed at any cost.
11. Smoking, consuming Alcohol, use of Illegal Drugs and Chewing of tobacco is strictly prohibited at the Range.

• It is mandatory for Shooters to have 02 identifications (Shooters ID and Aadhar Card) with them every time and have to present when asked by range officials and anyone from UPSRA.

• While filling online entries, shooters are required to be very careful as the details will be tallied every time by U.P. State Rifle Association.

**Change of District to Participate in Team Events**

Many shooters change their district during the ongoing shooting competitions, shooters can only fill their entries from the district of their domicile (Services, Armed forces, Transferable jobs exempted). And team entries will only be accepted once it is signed by the Governing Body member(s) and or by the General Body Member(s).

**Please note that if Medal winners are not present to receive their Medals, their Medals will be withheld.**

**Age Criteria:**

Sub Youth category (**10 to 16 years**), Youth category (**17 to 18 years**), Junior category (**19 to 20 years**), Senior category (**21 to 44 years**), Master category (**45 to 59 years**), Senior Master category (**60 to 69 years**), Super Master Category (**70 years and above**).

It is mandatory for Para Shooters to have their Certificates issued by Paralympic Committee of India (PCI) with them every time and have to present when asked by range officials and anyone from UPSRA.

**Only members of the Armed Forces (Army/Navy/Air Force, etc.) will be allowed to participate in "Services Category". There will be no Services category in ISSF Events.**

**IT IS MANDATORY FOR ATHLETES TO PARTICIPATE IN OPEN CATEGORY. Only Additional Entries in 'Civil Services Only' Category and 'Police Services' Category will be accepted at venue. In these categories sportsperson from Central administrative including state civil administrative and police service up to Gazetted officer rank can participate.**

**TEAM EVENTS:**

- Every shooter who is part of some particular district team will represent the same district in any other team event.
- All team entry forms duly filled along with entry fees to be submitted latest by 12:00 pm on 03.06.2026. Thereafter no team entries will be accepted.
- (ISSF) shooters will not be allowed to participate in (NR) events vice versa.

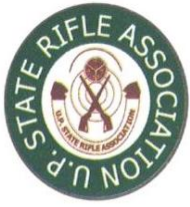

## **MEDAL PROTOCOL**

Medal winner should know the sequence when their name is being called out, and should rush to the podium and stand on their respective places.

If any medalist is not present in prize distribution ceremony, his coach, manager, guardian or anybody on his behalf can take the medal but he must not stand on the podium.

Coaches and Managers of teams and other concerned persons should direct that **medalist should be present at the ceremony.**
