



NATIONAL GAMES 2022

Dear Sir/Madam

The 2022 National Games will be held from 27th September 2022 onwards and Gujarat State is the host State. The exact dates and schedule will be notified in due course of time. The venue for Rifle/Pistol events will be AMRTA, Khanpur range, Ahmadabad. The venue for shotgun events will be informed shortly.

In consultation with SAI, it has been decided to conduct the matches in following events (Olympic events only). The list of events is as under:

A maximum of 3 shooters per State, per event, in individual and team events can participate. Two shooters (one male and one female) from the same state, who are participating in individual events, can participate in Mix Team events. Finals will be conducted in all events.

Since there are limited slots available for participation, the quota per state is allocated as stated below. This is based on the number of shooters participated in 64 NSCC in Senior events. The states can send their entries according to the quota allotted to them. A shooter can participate in multiple events, wherever qualified.

Selection of shooters, who have achieved MQS under Rule 17.6 NRAI Match Book, will be done by the respective State Rifle Associations. It is expected that the States would send their best teams for the prestigious National Games.

Under the principle of Universality, the NRAI may grant wild cards to States, whose shooters did not participate in NSCC



QUOTA DISTRIBUTION FOR NATIONAL GAMES 2022

The quota is decided on the number of shooters fielded by each State Rifle Association in 64 NSCC in the senior category. The number of shooters from Army, Navy and Air Force has been combined and shooters from these forces will represent SSCB, as per norms of OC National Games.

The number of shooters from Gujarat State, being the host state, will be decided by the Organizing Committee (OC).

Shooters from paramilitary organizations, like BSF, ITBP, CRPF, CISF, SSB and other Govt. organizations, like ONGC & Railways, may contact the state of their DOMICILE and slots for such shooters will be decided in consultation with the respective State Rifle Associations. It should be ensured that the shooters from these organizations represent their state of Domicile. This is as per the norms laid down by the Organizers.
